# Company overview.

**Experlogix** is a global software company specializing in **CPQ** (**Configure**, **Price**, **Quote**) and **Document Automation** solutions that help businesses simplify complex sales and document processes. Following multiple mergers, the company now operates across five entities in the **U.S.**, **Canada**, **the Netherlands**, **Belgium**, **and Ireland**, managing multiple currencies, products, and billing models.

With a lean finance team supporting recurring revenue and subscription billing across these regions, Experlogix needed a more efficient and reliable system to manage deferrals, revenue recognition, invoicing, and financial reporting across entities.

# Challenge.

As Experlogix grew, its accounting processes became increasingly difficult to manage. The mergers left the team struggling with siloed systems and manual workloads. Multiple entities, currencies, and reporting standards were being tracked manually through spreadsheets — leading to errors, inefficiencies, and limited visibility across teams.

Manual revenue recognition and deferral schedules.

Lack of automation left the team relying on spreadsheets.

Disjointed reporting and manual data entry.

Manual data management carried a high risk of user error.

Multi-entity complexity.

The team had no system to manage the multiple companies and currencies resulting from the mergers.

We have five environments with different currencies, tax structures, and overlapping customers, and before Subscription Billing, it was difficult to manage that manually.

Experlogix implemented **Binary Stream's Subscription Billing** to automate billing, deferrals, and revenue recognition directly within **Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central**.

Automated deferral schedules and revenue recognition.

With support for multiple currencies and tax structures.

Flexible billing schedules for annual, quarterly, and custom renewal.

Allowing teams to automate renewals, extensions, and adjustments.
